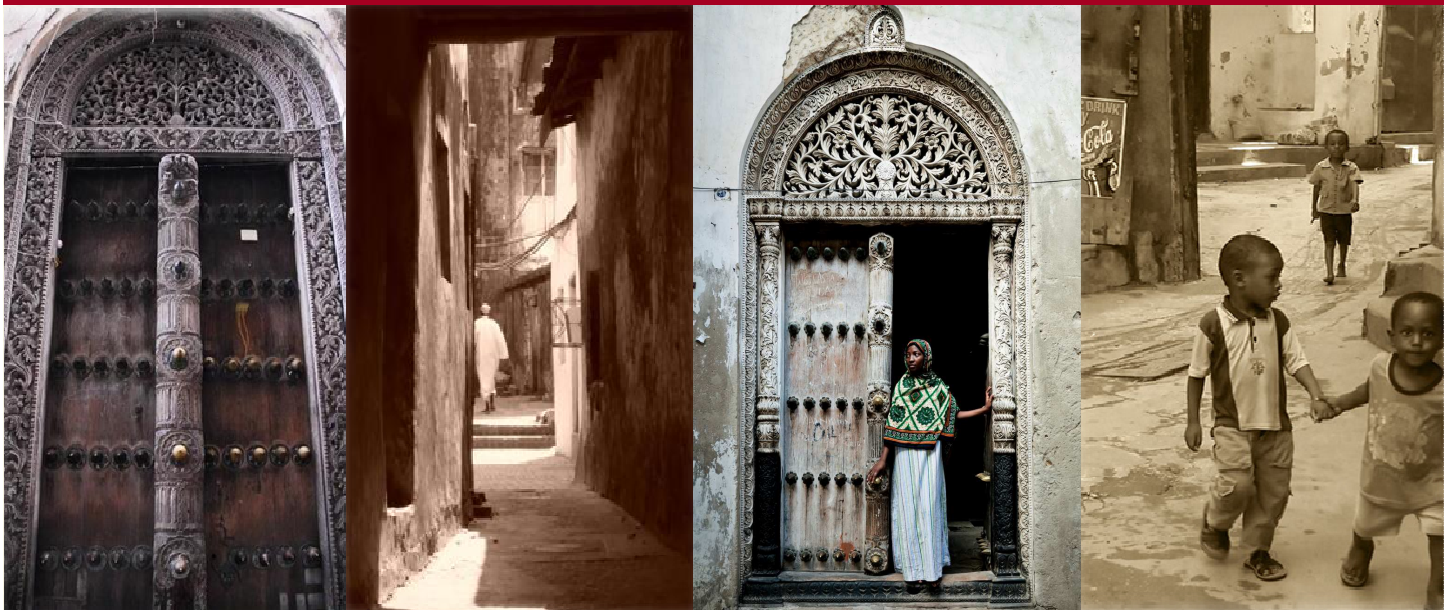




On Tour with Anna

Stone Town City Tour

The best way to get a feel for your surroundings and the people of Stone Town is making a tour around the city. Explore the former Slave Market, the Anglican Cathedral, the House of Wonders and the Sultan's Palace Museum, the Old Arab Fort and the Dispensary just to mention a few of the highlights. Apart from the 100's of carved doors you can find in the narrow streets of Stone Town, there are many more places you should visit to gain insight into the outstanding material manifestation of cultural fusion and harmonization.





Kizimkazi Dolphin Tour

Kizimkazi is home to large numbers of bottle-nosed and spinner dolphins, beautiful coral reefs and tropical fish. With this tour you'll start early in the morning driving to Kizimkazi, where your guide and crew take you out on your own boat so you can be as close as possible to the dolphins experiencing them in their natural environment. Enjoy also the tropical, crystal-clear, warm waters of the Indian Ocean.

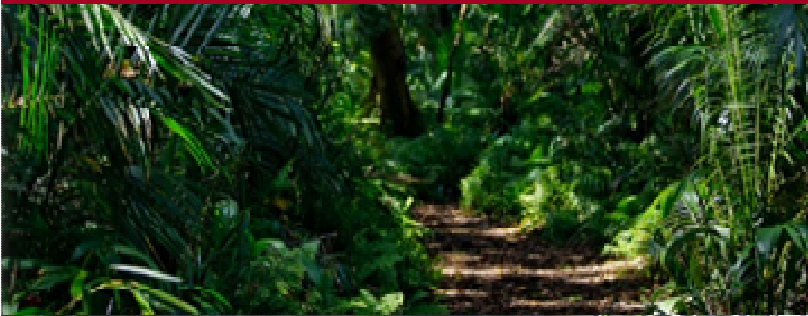




Jozani Forest

Jozani Forest is the only remaining natural forest in Zanzibar. It is situated close to “Anna of Zanzibar” and therefore perfect for a different kind of half day trip. The forest is home to a number of endemic species, including the Zanzibar Red Colobus Monkey. You will spot the monkeys in abundance all around the area, hence you just need a camera and sometimes a bit of patience.

The park ranger will take you on a natural trail, lined with eucalyptus and mahogany trees and explain the medicinal properties of various plants.





Spice Tour

One of the most popular excursions on the island. Walk through the spice farm with your guide and touch, smell and taste different spices and tropical fruits. Learn about their properties, their origins and their use as medicines and in food and drink. It can be quite surprising to see the range of different plants from which spices are obtained, and the different methods by which they are extracted. Apart from that, this tour also gives you a good insight into the local life of Swahili farmers.





Bwejuu Village

Gain an insight into a typically African village! The village is located 5 minutes drive from “Anna of Zanzibar” and neither affected nor influenced from the western culture. Therefore, you’ll have the unique possibility to see behind the curtain and figure out the lives of the locals. You can also gain insight into a traditional Swahili school. The tour takes about 3 hours.

Anna of Zanzibar supports the school of Bwejuu with donations of school benches made of hardwood to give the children a proper base for their education.
